Sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk until said date and time. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed as follows: Bid Enclosed: - Park Avenue Sanitary and Storm Sewer Improvements; ATTN: Engineering Dept.; South Haven DPW Building, 1199 8th Street, South Haven, Michigan 49090.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The work consists of storm and sanitary sewer reconstruction from Park Avenue to the Storm Sewer Outfall at the Black River. Reconstruction of Park Avenue, private parking lot improvements associated with the sewer replacement are also included in the work. Significant items of work are as follows:

All work must be substantially complete (open to traffic) on or before **May 13, 2011**, and finally complete including all landscaping and turf establishment on or before **June 30, 2011**.

Thereafter, Contract Documents may be viewed at this office during normal business hours (8:00 – 5:00), and may be obtained with payment of a \$50.00 non-refundable fee.

BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS & SECURITY:

Bids shall be submitted in accordance with, and upon, the original forms included in the Contract Documents. No Bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. No bid will be received or considered unless accompanied by a Bid Guaranty, payable to the City of South Haven in an amount not less than 5% of the base bid amount. The City of South Haven reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein, and to award the Contract as deemed to be in the best interests of the city.
