Sealed bids will be received by the City until said date and time. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed as follows: Bid Enclosed: - Williams Street Reconstruction Project; ATTN: Engineering Dept.; South Haven DPW Building, 1199 8th Street, South Haven, Michigan 49090.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The work consists of storm sewer, sanitary sewer, water main improvements on Williams Street from Eagle Street to Dyckman Avenue. Construction of pavement, sidewalk, parking, curb and gutter, and boardwalk is also included in this project.

All work must be substantially complete (open to traffic) on or before **May 18, 2012**, and finally complete including all landscaping and turf establishment on or before **May 25, 2012**.

BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS & SECURITY:

Bids shall be submitted in accordance with, and upon, the original forms included in the Contract Documents. No Bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. No bid will be received or considered unless accompanied by a Bid Guaranty, payable to the City of South Haven in an amount not less than 5% of the base bid amount. The City of South Haven reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein, and to award the Contract as deemed to be in the best interests of the city.

The successful bidder must comply with Davis Bacon Act requirements (Prevailing Federal Wage Rates and Labor Standards).
