**CEDAR STREET COMBINED SEWER OVERFLOW SEPARATION PROJECT
AND WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS**

The City of Manistee is requesting bids for approximately 4,500 feet of roadway, water main, and sewer work within the Cedar Street area. Sealed Bids will be received until **9:30 a.m., LOCAL TIME, February 7, 2011, at the City of Manistee, 70 Maple Street, P.O. Box 358, Manistee, Michigan 49660** at which time and place said bids will be opened and read aloud for the **Cedar Street Combined Sewer Overflow Separation Project and Water Distribution System Improvements.**

All bids shall be addressed to the **City of Manistee, Clerk's Office**, at the above address. Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder and the contract for which the bid is being submitted on the outside of the envelope. All bidders shall bid in accordance with and upon the bid forms included in the contract documents. No bids will be received after the designated time stated above.

Contract documents are on file for inspection at City Hall and ABONMARCHE. Contract documents may be obtained from ABONMARCHE 361 First Street, Manistee, Michigan, 49660 (231) 723-1198 for a non-refundable fee of **\$150.00** for each set.

A certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid, made payable to the City of Manistee will be required with each bid as security for the proper execution of the contract. A 100% Labor, Material, and Performance Bond will be required of successful bidder.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the scheduled opening without consent of the OWNER.

All bidders must comply with DBE "good faith efforts" and EPA form submittals or their bid will be considered non-responsive.

The successful bidder must comply with Davis Bacon Act requirements (Prevailing Federal Wage Rates and Labor Standards).

The City of Manistee reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bid or bids should it consider same to be in its best interest.
