INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids will be received until 2:00 p.m., LOCAL TIME, on April 14, 2011 at the City of Benton Harbor Municipal Building, Clerks Office, 175 Territorial Road, Benton Harbor, MI 49022 at which time and place said bids will be opened publicly for the projects below:

- John Street Sewer Replacement - 1,100 ft of sanitary sewer replacement and road reconstruction
- Ox Creek Sewer Lining & Lift Station Rehabilitation – 1,800 ft of sanitary sewer lining, replacement of 3 lift stations, and rehabilitation of 6 existing sanitary sewer lift stations.

All bids shall be addressed to the City of Benton Harbor, at the above address. Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder and the contract for which the bid is being submitted on the outside of the envelope. All bidders shall bid in accordance with and upon the bid forms included in the contract documents. No bids will be received after the designated time stated above.

The contract documents for bidding purposes may be obtained from ABONMARCHE, 95 W. Main Street, Benton Harbor, Michigan, 49022 (269) 927-2295. Copies of the contract documents may be obtained from the above for a non-refundable fee of \$50.00 for each set.

A certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid, made payable to City of Benton Harbor will be required with each bid as security for the proper execution of the contract. A 100% Labor, Material, and Performance Bond will be required of successful bidder.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the scheduled opening without consent of the OWNER.

The City of Benton Harbor Local Minority Policy requires that 25% of subcontracted work be performed by local minority contractors.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bid, consistent with law, which best serves the interest of the Owner.
