RE: SRF #5602-01-2a Monroe Boulevard & Indian Grove Lift Station Project Update

Background

Construction on Monroe Boulevard and the Indian Grove Lift Station is set to start next week. We expect to see the contractor stage traffic control on Monday and Tuesday and begin road work on Tuesday and Wednesday. The project involves extensive improvements to underground utilities, including sanitary sewers, storm drainage, and water main. As shown in the rendering at left, the new roadway will feature curb and gutter and a sidewalk on the east side of the street. The project is scheduled to start in Late September 2016 and finish in Summer 2017.



During construction, the roadway will be closed to thru traffic. Traffic will be detoured as shown on the attached map. Access to driveways will be maintained as much as possible. There will be times when you may be unable to access your driveways due to utility construction, concrete and asphalt paving operations. We will work with the contractor to minimize these periods.

Phase 1:

The initial phase of work will be focused on the stretch of Monroe Boulevard from the South City Limit at Evergreen Bluff Drive to Lovejoy Avenue. Work will commence with the removal of the existing pavement and other surface improvements. Underground work will begin with installation of new storm sewers and catch basins.
