RE: SRF #5602-01-2a Monroe Boulevard & Indian Grove Lift Station Project Update

**Current Progress:**

Underground construction is underway. Kalin Construction is working on placing new storm sewer between Clarke Place and Lovejoy Avenue. There are many underground utilities in this section of roadway. The contractor is working carefully around these utilities. Earlier this week an underground phone line near 3<sup>rd</sup> Street was damaged, but not totally severed. You may have noticed that this area has been left open and barricaded with snow fence. Kalin and AbonmarCHE have been in contact with Frontier Communications since the incident occurred, and we are attempting to expedite the repair work.



**Construction Schedule:**

Kalin anticipates directional boring work may be underway near the end of this week and may continue into next week. New water main will be directionally drilled (tunneled) underneath the creek on the west side of the road between Clarke Place and Lovejoy. Once this is complete, they will use the same method to drill a new force main from Monroe to the Lift Station on Summerwood Drive. These new pipes will be installed several feet beneath the creek bed and will eliminate two aerial crossings.



Once the directional drilling is complete, Kalin will install the remainder of the water main, including replacement of the services to your home. Please note that water main installation will involve work on the west side of the roadway. The Kalin's crew will retain existing pavement on the west side of the roadway as long as possible, but there will come a time when this pavement must be removed.

Weekly "tailgate talks" will continue to take place on Thursdays at 9:30 a.m. for anyone with project-related questions or needs. Those meetings are held at the intersection of Monroe Boulevard and Lovejoy Avenue.
