RE: SRF #5602-01-2a Monroe Boulevard & Indian Grove Lift Station Project Update

Current Progress:

Monroe Boulevard is continuing to take shape. Construction crews are installing sidewalks and driveways. Storm sewer is complete on Lovejoy.

South of Lovejoy, Kalin continues making progress on the lift station and force main work. Control panel and electrical equipment will be installed this week and next.



Construction Schedule:

Concrete work will continue. The road crew is coordinating their work with electrical utility relocation.

The new Indian Grove Lift Station is nearing completion. Following successful testing of the new station, the old block structure will be demolished, an emergency standby generator will be installed, and the site will be restored.

Thursday, May 4, 2017, the mailboxes south of Lovejoy will be relocated to the west side of the road. Affected residents have been notified with door hangers.

Weekly "tailgate talks" continue to take place on Thursdays at 9:30 a.m. for anyone with project-related questions or needs. Those meetings are held at the intersection of Monroe Boulevard and Lovejoy Avenue.

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE
Monroe Boulevard and Indian Grove Force Main Replacement Project

The following activities will be occurring as part of the construction. We anticipate these activities will occur on the following dates:
Week of April 24, 2017

- The street will be closed to through traffic. Access will be maintained to your property and driveway. If you cannot access your driveway, park in the nearest cross street or designated parking area. Police have been notified.
- Please turn off service to irrigation systems, landscape lighting, etc. and mark existing grade measurements. You are encouraged to arrange your own privately owned equipment prior to construction. The contractor will endeavor to acquire and lay back the cut area of irrigation piping or similar, but these systems will likely require repair or replacement following construction.
- Concrete trucks will be placed at your driveway approach. To prevent damage to your concrete, please do not use your driveway until you receive notification that the concrete has cured sufficiently to receive traffic. This typically takes **approximately 14 days**. You will receive a follow-up notice when it is okay to resume using your driveway.
- Paving operations will be conducted on your street. There will be periods of time when you are unable to use your driveway. Please schedule your activities prior to paving and do not drive on new asphalt until paving is complete and barriers have been removed.
- Due to utility construction, you may experience water or sewer service interruptions. Notice of service will be provided by _____.
- Your driveway may be inaccessible due to utility construction. Work is anticipated to be completed by _____.
- Your lawn has not been treated with liquid, weed and fertilizer. In order to establish good grass growth, please water at least twice per week. Do not mow until the grass reaches 2 inches in height.
