## ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

**PROJECT:**           **South Haven Pump Track**

**BID OPENING:**       **December 2, 2016, at 2:00 p.m., local time**

**NOTICE:**

Sealed bids will be received by the City until said date and time. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed as follows: Bid Enclosed: South Haven Pump Track; ATTN: Engineering Dept.; South Haven DPW Building, 1199 8<sup>th</sup> Street, South Haven, Michigan 49090.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The work consists of grading existing spoils located on site with fill added to develop the alignment and profile for the track (rough grading). Rollers and berms will be installed for pump track features. Also included is drainage, sidewalk, and HMA parking to the site.

All work must be substantially complete (Earthwork, Grading, and Restoration) on or before **May 1, 2017**, and finally complete including all paving and project cleanup on or before **May 19, 2017**.

**CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:**

Contract Documents will be available after **1:00 P.M., November 14, 2016**, from Abonmarche, 95 West Main Street, Benton Harbor, Michigan 49022 and can be obtained with payment of a \$50.00 non-refundable fee. Thereafter, Contract Documents may be viewed at this office during normal business hours (8:00 – 5:00). Contract Documents will also be available electronically at no cost and can be downloaded from the City of South Haven website, or requested from Abonmarche. Please contact Abonmarche to be added to the plan holders list if Contract Documents are obtained electronically.

**BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS & SECURITY:**

Bids shall be submitted in accordance with, and upon, the original forms included in the Contract Documents. No Bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. No bid will be received or considered unless accompanied by a Bid Guaranty, payable to the City of South Haven in an amount not less than 5% of the base bid amount. The City of South Haven reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein, and to award the Contract as deemed to be in the best interests of the city.
