

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Norton Shores is seeking sealed bids for the Vulcan Street Water Main Replacement Project.

The work will include approximately 1,225 feet of 8-inch Ductile Iron Watermain and associated valves, fittings, and Hydrants in Vulcan Street from Broadway Ave to Sherman Blvd. In addition to the watermain replacement work, roadway removal, machine grading, paving, restoration and all related work will be completed. Bids will be received by the City Purchasing Agent, Norton Shores City Hall, 4814 Henry Street, Norton Shores, Michigan until **10:00 a.m., February 23, 2023**, after which time and place proposals will no longer be accepted.

Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the designated website. Prospective Bidders are urged to register with the designated website as a plan holder, even if Bidding Documents are obtained from a plan room or source other than the designated website in either electronic or paper format. The designated website will be updated periodically with addenda, lists of registered plan holders, reports, and other information relevant to submitting a bid for the Project. All official notifications, addenda, and other Bidding Documents will be offered through the designated website. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the designated website.

Construction shall be per the Michigan Department of Transportation 2020 Standard Specifications for Construction and the attached specifications. The Contractor may begin the work once a Notice to Proceed has been issued. The City has ordered the ductile iron water main pipe materials for this project and anticipates delivery of the material by mid-May/June 2023. All work shall be completed by August 18, 2023, or 10 weeks from the start of construction, whichever is sooner (depending on the availability of materials). Contractor shall be responsible for the six percent (6%) use tax, payable to the State of Michigan.

A certified check, bank draft, or bid bond in the sum of not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the proposal will be required with each bid.

The City will award the project in a manner determined to be in the best interest of the City.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids in the best interest of the City.
